Arni Psito Tis Souvlas – (Lamb Dinner:) young lamb, seasoned with traditional Greek spices and slowly barbecued over a charcoal fire. (Please note: Only so many lambs are prepared each day, once we sell out, there are no more available for that day) **Dinner.....\$17.00.....Ala cart.....\$16.00**

Souvlaki – (Shish-ka-bob Dinner:) Pork marinated in lemon juice, olive oil, oregano and other Greek spices then barbecued over an outdoor charcoal fire pit..... **Dinner.....\$11.00.....by the skewer.....\$5.00**

Kota Riganati – (Greek Style Chicken Dinner:) Half chicken marinated in lemon juice, olive oil, oregano and other Greek spices, then slowly cooked trapping in all the tasty, rich flavor... **Dinner...\$10.00.....Ala cart.....\$9.00**

Pastisio – Large piece of Greek Lasagna with salad and dinner roll. ... (Saturday and Sunday Only)..... **\$11.00**

Fish Dinner–Baked Cod in tomato, parsley, onion & olive oil (Fri. only) **\$10.00**
